Last May, an audience of some 400 million worldwide watched the coronation of King Charles III and Queen Camilla. An undisputed star of the event was the Gold State Coach whose painted panels are the work of an Italian artist who moved to London in 1755 and was to spend the rest of his life in England: Giovanni Battista Cipriani. As it is still considered the greatest collective work of 18th century England, this royal carriage will be the perfect vehicle to introduce Cipriani's working relationships and discuss the various forms through which the artist's talent found expression. Although Cipriani's reputation has undeniably dimmed during the last century, in this talk Antonella Guarracino, independent art historian, in conversation with Adrian Le Harivel, Curator of British Art at the National Gallery of Ireland, will make a persuasive case for remembering the Florentine artist's contribution to the development of the visual arts in England and Ireland

For the third autumnal event of "Lunedì al Cinema" we will present the film "Così parlò Bellavista" (1984), a "philosophic" comedy by the Neapolitan author Luciano De Crescenzo which portrays, with unforgettable protagonists, the sterotypes found in Italy during the 80's. It evolves into an extremely ironic choral tale which describes the prejudices regarding the city of Napoli and its inhabitants, conveyed as characters of a theatrical play. The plot recounts the story of a Neapolitan apartment block whose pleasant immutability is disrupted by the arrival of a Milanese family. A conflict arises, with dispassionate division, between the Neapolitan philosophy of life and that pertinent to Milan. The film will be screened in Italian with English subtitles, preceded by an analysis on the context and works of the director. Entry is free upon registration.

For the fourth autumn appointment of the "Lunedì al Cinema" series we will present the film "Buongiorno, notte" (2003) by director Marco Bellocchio, a film with a historical-social theme that, by mixing novelisation with original television documents of the 70's, recalls the human drama of the statesman Aldo Moro - murdered in 1978 - and the doubt that he had made its way into Chiara, one of the terrorists of the Red Brigades who kidnapped him. The plot is loosely taken from the 1998 book "The Prisoner" by former Red Brigade member Anna Laura Braghetti. The film will be screened in Italian with English subtitles and preceded by an analysis of the context and the director's work. Free admission.


