The Italian Institute of Culture is delighted to bring to Dublin the photographic exhibition about Italian Street Art "Vedo a Colori – Greetings from the Harbour", curated by Giulio Vesprini and Cristina Ciampaglione. The exhibition will be hosted by the Irish Architectural Archive, 45 Merrion Square East, D2, from the 6th to the 24th of November 2023. "Vedo a Colori" is an urban regeneration project that, for the past 10 years, has redeveloped the docklands of Civitanova Marche (Italy) though the use of street art. All art enthusiasts will be welcome to visit the exhibition for free at the Irish Architectural Archive, from Monday to Friday, 10am-5pm.

The inaugural event, which will take place the 6th of November, will kick off with the screening of the documentary "Un documentario al Porto" (60') at the Italian Institute of Culture. A story of images and sounds that will trace the development through the years of the port in Civitanova Marche and how, thanks to the Street Art Festival "Vedo a Colori", it turned into an actual Urban Art Museum. Bursting with new colours, it becomes a space for everybody to enjoy, changing the appeal of the city starting right from its centre. I4 years in existence, 105 artists, 15 schools, 18 shipyards, 2000 square metres of painted art on the town pier make of this Festival an authentic open air museum. From the 9th to the 19th November 2023 Ireland will join in the celebration of the 8th edition of the Week of I the Italian Cuisine in the World. Organised by the Embassy of Italy in Ireland, the Italian Trade and Investment Agency (ITA), and the Italian Irish Chamber of Commerce, together with the Italian National Tourist Board (ENIT) and the Italian Institute of Culture, this edition focuses on healthy food inspired by Mediterranean diet and is titled: "At the Table with Italian Cuisine: Health with Taste". On the 15th November at 6.15pm, you are invited to the screening of the movie "Gualtiero Marchesi: The Great Italian" (2018, 80', directed by Maurizio Gigola), about the chef who brought a revolution to Italian Cuisine in the past 50 years, bringing it to the forefront of international gastronomy. It will also be an opportunity to taste some authentic Italian specialties during the toast that will follow the screening. The film traces the life and thoughts of Marchesi since the 1930s and the years traveling around the world, in particular in France during his apprenticeship, and finally his return to Milan in the 70s and the opening of his legendary restaurant, in via Bonvesin de la Riva, the first one in Italy to obtain three *Michelin* stars in 1985. EXHIBITION "IL PERUGINO. IL MEGLIO MAESTRO D'ITALIA"

On Thursday I6 November 2023, the exhibition of I5 educational panels in English and Italian illustrating the figure of Pietro Vannucci, a Renaissance painter known as "II Perugino", will be on display on the 3rd floor of the UCD School of Languages, Cultures and Linguistic, thanks to the collaboration with the UCD Italian Department. The exhibition - already on in Galway and Cork Universities - includes the reproduction of a series of paintings and captions that tell the story of the painter, active in Florence during the Medicis period, between the end of the I5th and the beginning of the I6th Century, where Verrocchio, Ghirlandaio, Sandro Botticelli, Leonardo, Raphael and Michelangelo also worked. The materials are designed and created by Stefano Baldi and exhibited for the occasion in various IIC locations around the world. Free entry.

A movie highly acclaimed by a whole generation during the Nineties, Gabriele Salvatore's *Mediterraneo* (1991) won the Academy Award as Best Foreign movie in 1992, reinforcing the international fame of Salvatores within the so-called "tetralogy of escape", comprising "Marrakech Express" (1989), "Turnè" (1990) and "Puerto Escondido" (1992). It consists of four movies directed by Salvatores centred upon the theme of disillusionment and escape towards a new identity in terms of inner self, individualism, and finding a form of commitment detached from ideology and collective metanarratives, but led instead by charismatic and ironic role models. The film will be screened in Italian with English subtitles and will be introduced by an analysis of its context and the director's work. Free admission, booking recommended.

Dublin in the 1750s was a musical melting pot, attracting musicians of the highest calibre from all over Europe, many of whom were virtuoso Italians. One such virtuoso, Francesco Geminiani, settled in the city, and regularly frequented his Irish patron in Cootehill, Co. Cavan. Legend has it that on one occasion Geminiani undertook the journey by foot, perhaps passing through Co. Louth on the way. 'Geminiani in Ardee' represents the vibrant Italian sound world that was fashionable with Dublin audiences at the time, and revives it in the place where Geminiani's own feet may have walked, nearly 300 years ago.
