"DUO SCIAPÒ" CANTA LIVE FABRIZIO DE ANDRÉ

Tribute concert for guitar and violin remembering the singer 25 years after his death

The 11th of January 1999 is sadly remembered as the day when one of the most famous Italian singer songwriter passed away: Fabrizio De André is behind some of the most unforgettable lyrics and ballads, which had a great impact on generations of Italian listeners. Twenty-five years after his untimely death, the Italian Institute of Culture is delighted to present a tribute to rediscover some of De André's best songs, re-arranged for guitar and violin by Duo Sciapò, who merge the work of songwriters and traditional music with a passion for Ireland. The one hour and a half show will offer a unique experience by performing the biggest hits of this iconic Ligurian singer. Duo Sciapò, born in 2016 from a shared interest in traditional music and street art, is composed by Sara Cesano (violin) and Sergio Pozzi (voice and guitar). In 2024, the series of "Lunedì al Cinema" will bring to the Institute 'big screen' nine contemporary movies (plus a tenth, 1949 "Riso Amaro") revolving around the theme "Snapshots from Contemporary Italy". The first evening will offer the debut as director of the famous Roman actress Claudia Gerini, who in 2022 directed and starred in Tapirulàn. Plot: Emma works from home as a psychologist and she never goes out. She offers consultations to her clients through a screen in an attempt to improve their lives, while running on a treadmill for many hours a day. Her younger sister finds her after 26 years, disrupting the deceptive balance that Emma created for herself. The movie will be screened in Italian with English subtitles and introduced by a brief analysis of its context and the director's work. The first tour of the year will present the city of Rome and its underground wonders. Buried beneath the surface of ancient Rome, where the Foro, Colosseum and the other innumerable well-known monuments stand, another fascinating Rome, but rarely seen, awaits to be discovered. During this guided tour we will delve into the city's hidden depths, where millennia of transformation have left behind forgotten catacombs, crypts, temples, outstanding Domus Romane, like Celio's or Palazzo Valentini, and other amazing underworld places. Not only burial sites, but places where Romans used to inhabit, showing signs of their daily life and entertainment. The Italian Institute of Culture reopens its symphonic season for 2024 with a proposal for harp and piano featuring the 'Duo Liaison', composed of the young talents Emma and Virginia Pestugia, who will perform in Dublin. The young musicians, winners of international competitions, will present a program of duo and solo pieces by C. Debussy (Estampes: Pagodes, La soirée dans Grenade, Jardins sous la pluie), C. Debussy (Reverie), M. Ravel (Ma mere l'oye), H. Renie (Pièce Symphonique), J. Turina (Ciclo Plateresco). Emma Pestugia (piano) was a finalist at the 8th YPN – Young Pianist of the North competition in Newcastle, and later won the First Prize at the Grand Prize Virtuoso International Music Competition in Vienna, making her debut at the Musikverein. Virginia Pestugia (harp) has won more than 10 international awards, including the First Prize at the Korea International Harp Competition 2022. Every year, the network of Embassies and Institutes of Culture commemorates Holocaust Remembrance Day, in memory of all the victims of the Holocaust, racial laws, and all Italian military and political deportees in Nazi camps. On January 25th, at the Italian Institute of Culture, we will host dr. Mara Josi, a young researcher from Ghent University (formerly UCD), who will present her monography "Rome, 16 October 1943. History, Memory, Literature" (Legenda, 2023), on the deportation of Italian Jews. Following the presentation, the documentary film "1938 - Diversi" (2018 - 60'), directed by Giorgio Treves, will be screened in Italian with English subtitles. The film was presented at the 75th Venice Film Festival and won the 2019 Nastro d'Argento Award for Best Documentary. Free admission.
