#### "GUGLIELMO MARCONI AND THE WAVES OF MADE IN ITALY"

Exhibition on the inventor of the Radio at the dlr LexIcon Library in Dún Laoghaire Exhibition open from 14 April to 8 June 2025 Monday to Sunday during library opening hours dlr LexIcon Library and Cultural Centre - Dún Laoghaire

Last days to visit the exhibition organized to mark the 150th anniversary of the birth of Italian scientist Guglielmo Marconi, hosted by the Embassy of Italy in Ireland, the Italian Cultural Institute, and the Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council at the dlr LexIcon Library and Cultural Centre in Dún Laoghaire. The exhibition, open until the 8th of June, features 12 historical artifacts that trace the story of Guglielmo Marconi's scientific achievements, including transmitting and receiving devices, telegraphs and radios, as well as photographs and archival footage from Istituto Luce and the Historical Museum of Communications in Rome, alongside images from the Italian Navy and the RAI broadcasting company. #### MARCONI & IRISH PRIMADONNA MARGARET BURKE SHERIDAN

Lecture-concert on the encounter and patronage by Marconi of Irish soprano, with Puccini's arias In collaboration with Irish National Opera Thursday 29 May 2025 at 6.30 pm The Studio Theatre - dlr LexIcon Library - Dún Laoghaire Free registration on Eventbrite

Margaret Burke Sheridan (1889-1958) was an Irish opera singer considered the second Irish Prima Donna, after Catherine Hayes. From 1909 to 1911 she studied at the Royal Academy of Music in London, where she met Guglielmo Marconi, who helped her in arranging her further opera studies in Rome. With Marconi's help, she made her debut there in January 1918 in Puccini's "La Bohème". In subsequent years she sang at "La Scala" with great success. Biographer Anne Chambers, author of 'La Sheridan: Adorable Diva 1889-1958', will retrace the remarkable story of this Irish Prima Donna and how, with Marconi's help, she conquered the stages of the opera world, in an evening with 3 Puccini arias performed live by Rachel Croash (soprano) and Annalisa Monticelli (piano) and with the presentation of documents and letters published between the two protagonists. #### "PANORAMA - COLLECTIVA"

A painting and photography exhibition curated by Radio Ireland

From 6 to 19 June, the Institute will host the exhibition "Panorama - Collectiva", a look at the Irish art scene with a focus on painting and photography, two complementary and interactive art forms. The project, curated and produced by Radio Ireland, includes the exhibition of works by painters Sol Robinson, Louise Meade, Ferdinando Adiletta and photographers Fabio Grassi, Ishmael Claxton and Rèmi Parnaud. The inauguration will take place on Friday 6 June at 6:30 pm with live interviews with the artists, readings of some of the artists' poems and a free guided tour of the exhibition, with the opportunity to engage informally with the artists. A toast will then be offered to the participants. Access to the exhibition is free on weekdays from Friday 6 to Thursday 19 June from 10:00 to 13:00 and from 15:00 to 17:00 (on 11 June the exhibition will not be open to visitors due to a concurrent event). Film screening "Rapito/Kidnapped" (2023) by Marco Bellocchio - ITA sub ENG Monday 9 June 2025 at 6.00 pm Italian Institute of Culture, Pavilion Hall Free booking on <u>iicdublino.esteri.it</u> or <u>Eventbrite</u>

"Rapito/Kidnapped" (2023) is a film by Marco Bellocchio that has won four David di Donatello 2024 Awards, and that is still competing in various festivals. In 1858, in the Jewish quarter of Bologna, the Pope's soldiers burst into the home of the Mortara family. By order of the cardinal, they have come to take Edgardo, their seven-year-old son who had been secretly baptized by his nurse. The papal law is unquestionable: he must receive a Catholic education. The Mortaras' struggle quickly takes a political dimension, but the Church and the Pope will not agree to return the child, to consolidate an increasingly wavering power... The film will be screened in Italian with English subtitles and will be preceded by an analysis of its context and the director's work. Free entry with booking on our website or Eventbrite.

#### GIRO D'IRLANDA BEYOND LIMITS NOT JUST ULTRACYCLING

With the Paralympic athlete Andrea Pusateri Thursday 12 June 2025 at 6.00 pm Italian Institute of Culture - Pavilion Hall Invitation-only event

"Beyond Limits - not just Ultracycling" is a digital documentary series created by Andrea Pusateri, a Paracycling champion and élite athlete. In 2023, Andrea decided to go beyond, dedicating himself to Ultracycling challanges: extreme distance cyclistic competitions. Despite his disability, which doesn't allow him to take part in the competitions of this discipline, he created a personalised series of cycling experiences that allow him to challenge himself and his abilities. On his social media, he documents and shares all his feats with the public. The 12<sup>th</sup> of June at the Institute, he will present the project "Giro d'Irlanda" in 16 stages around the island for a total of 2600km, from 15<sup>th</sup> of June to 1<sup>st</sup> of July 2025. A discussion on sports and disability, including Pusateri himself along with some Irish authorities, will follow. Invitation only event.

"Che bella giornata/What a nice day!" (2011) is a movie directed by Gennaro Nunziante starring Checco Zalone (stage name of Luca Medici). It is Zalone's second film, after "Cado dalle nubi"s great success in 2009. A comedy that mixes humour, social satire and romanticism, which soundtrack also includes iconic - and linked to the plot's context - original songs sung by Zalone himself. "Che bella giornata" has earned over 43 million euros, becoming the highest-grossing Italian film of all time at the time (later surpassed by other films by Zalone himself) and has consolidated the actor as one of the most loved and successful comedians of the contemporary Italian cinema. ### ELENA MATTEUCCI AND DANIELE ORLANDO IN CONCERT

Did you know that the relationship between Robert and Clara Schumann and Johannes Brahms is one of the most fascinating relationships in the history of romantic music? In 1853, a young Johannes Brahms visited the Schumanns, bringing with him some of his compositions. Robert Schumann, already a famous composer and music critic, was immediately struck by Brahms' talent and called him "the chosen one". From then on, the destinies of the three composers remained inextricably linked. The Institute's spring music season ends the next 25th June with an exceptional violin and piano concert by the Duo Elena Matteucci (piano) and Daniele Orlando (violin) performing music by Clara Schumann (1819–1896), Robert Schumann (1810–1856), Johannes Brahms (1833–1897) and Camille Saint Saens (1835-1921). A journey through the Romantic and Late-Romantic atmospheres, including some of the most famous romances and sonatas. Approximate duration: 65 min. An event not to be missed! 
