## THE "LEONESSA" BY ARTIST DAVIDE BIVALTA

IN THE COURTYARD OF DUBLIN CASTLE

From June 2023 to April 2024 Dublin Castle - Courtyard Dame St. - Dublin

From June 2023 to April 2024, the Italian sculptor Davide Rivalta will be present in Ireland with 10 of his bronze works. In the main court yard of the prestigious Dublin Castle, the bronze sculpture "Leonessa" will be accessible to the public from the 1st of June 2023. This sculpture, whose weight is approx. 700kg, will be installed within the Castle's court yard, with the possibility of free entry for all visitors. The work will be accompanied by 8 buffalo sculptures and one of a horse displayed, for the same period, in the park of the Italian Ambassador in Ireland's Residence at Lucan House. The project was made possible by the collaboration with the Galleria Nazionale di Arte Moderna e Contemporanea di Roma and OPW Dublin Castle.


