From the 6th to the 11th December we celebrate contemporary art with **Contemporary Art Day**, an initiative supported by **AMACI (Association of Italian Contemporary Art Museum)**. On-line and live events are organized throughout December in Dublin, headlined by an extraordinary permanent videoart installation at the Institute. The 16th of December pianist **Analisa Monticelli** will perform a live soundtrack to the exhibition.

The online guided tour with Artaway are also part of the programme. This month we will discover contemporary art in Milan and Naples. Not to be missed an English guided tour about Italian Street Art!

As part of a series of encounters link to the IIC Book Club, we will be virtually hosting the writer **Federica Sgaggio**, author of **“L’eredità dei vivi/The legacy of the living”**. "Favolacce" is a 2020 Swiss-Italian movie, written and directed by Damiano and Fabio D'Innocenzo. It was presented at the 2020 Berlin Film Festival, where it won the award for best script. In a small popular district at the suburbs of Rome, the heat of the Summer hides a suffocating atmosphere of alienation. From afar, the families living there look normal, but that's an illusion: in the houses, the courtyards and the gardens, silence wraps around the fathers' subtle sadism, the mothers' passivity, and the culpable indifference of the grown-ups...



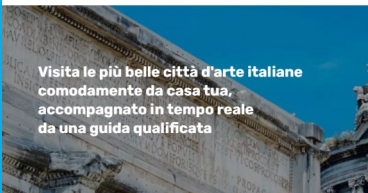

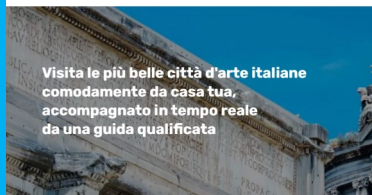

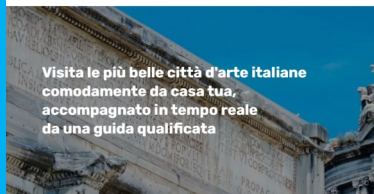
Screening of the movie

"Meninas Duo" concert

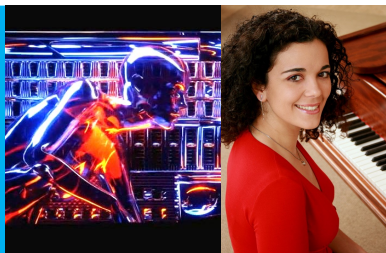
