






"Italian Carnival Masks"

Milan has been the capital of Italian Design for almost a hundred years. Let's explore its history through an online guided tour in English. Lunedì al cinema on MyMovies Screening of "Qui rido io/The King of Laughter" (2021) in Neapolitan dialect with English subtitles



"Qui rido io" (The King of Laughter) is a 2021 film directed by Mario Martone that revisits the life of the king of Neapolitan comedians, the great actor and playwright Eduardo Scarpetta, played here by Toni Servillo. Scarpetta, the biological father of Titina, Eduardo and Peppino De Filippo, dedicated his life to theater, creating works that have become timeless classics, such as "Miseria e nobiltà". He achieved great success and was the protagonist of a great dispute with Gabriele D'Annunzio for "The Son of Iorio", a parody of the poet's work who was at the center of a memorable trial. Monday 21st March at 6pm will be launched in the rooms on the first floor of the Italian Institute of Culture the exhibition "Dubliners", a collection of a series of drawings by Italian illustrator Mario Sughi (nerosunero), who has been living and working in Dublin for decades. "Dubliners" is the first exhibition organized by the Italian Institute of Culture in the context of "L'Illustrazione italiana 2022", which will bring to the attention of people in Dublin 5 exhibitions by 6 different artists (5 Italian and one Irish) throughout 2022. A modern and fascinating journey about the art of Illustration which will range from illustrations for children to street art. We will be launching, on Friday 25 March, a series of free concerts (of about 45 min.) which will be held at Lunchtime (between 1pm and 2pm) in the Pavillion Hall of our Institute. The first captivating appointment, in collaboration with the TU Dublin Conservatory, will be a concert-show on the life of Emilia Giuliani, Italian guitarist and composer of the nineteenth century. The performance by Federica Artuso (guitar) and Nicoletta Confalone (lyrics and narrating voice) includes songs by the composer and the narration, in English, of some anecdotes about her life. The editors Manuele Gragnolati (University Paris-Sorbonne), Elena Lombardi (University of Oxford), and Francesca Southerden (University of Oxford) will take part in a dialogue with scholars Igor Candido (Trinity College Dublin) and Daragh O' Connell (University College Cork).
