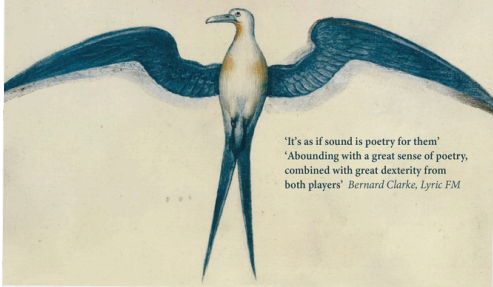
**Bloomsday in Galway: Stories of James Joyce and his muse Nora Barnacle**
